

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-02

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A PRIVILEGE TAX UPON THE OCCUPANCY
IN ANY HOTEL OR MOTEL OR ANY PLACE IN WHICH ROOMS,
LODGING OR ACCOMMODATIONS ARE FURNISHED
TO TRANSIENTS FOR CONSIDERATION

WHEREAS, Public Chapter 496, Acts of 2021 authorizes the City of LaFollette, Tennessee, to levy by Ordinance an occupancy or hotel/motel tax; and

WHEREAS, the City of LaFollette, Tennessee, deems it to be in the best interest of the City to have such a tax.

WHEREAS, the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of LaFollette, Tennessee, will be positively impacted by the adoption of this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL
OF THE City OF LAFOLLETTE, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:


- (1) "Exhibit A" attached herein is hereby adopted and shall be codified in its entirety.

- (3) The effective date of this Ordinance shall be the date of adoption unless otherwise stated herein.


