All letters of interest must be received by City of LaFollette on or before 2:00 p.m., October 18, 2018. The letter of interest and qualifications shall indicate the scope of services to be completed by any sub-consultants.



Phase I Evaluation

City of LaFollette will evaluate the top 3 firms for each contract on the following criteria (relative weight):

- Ability and relevant expertise of the firm's personnel to be used in performing (15%).
- b. Past experience in the required disciplines with TDOT and/or other clients (15%).
- c. Qualification and availability of staff (10%).
- d. Demonstrated ability to meet schedules without compromising sound engineering practice (10%).
- e. Evaluations on prior projects with TDOT and other clients, if available (10%).
- f. Size of project and limited or unlimited pregualification status (10%).
- g. Amount of work under contract with TDOT and other clients (10%).
- h. Ability to perform work efficiently without compromising sound engineering practice (10%).
- i. Familiarity of the firm with the community's conditions and improvement needs (10%).

The consultant evaluation committee holds the ability to conduct interviews based on scoring as Phase II Evaluation.
